Topic based learning: Space X Nasa Mission

Each week I shall suggest some topic ideas that you might like to explore.

ENGLISH Imagine you are going to the moon. Write a story about your adventure. Don't forget to include lots of descriptions of what you can see, hear, touch and smell. How do you feel? Remember stories need a problem at the start and a resolution at the end.

SCIENCE Find out about the solar system. What are the names of the different planets? How are they similar? How are they different? Can you think of a Mnemonic to help you remember the order of the planets? Illustrate a poster with your mnemonic and some facts about the planets.

GEOGRAPHY There are many craters on the moon. Choose one and find out about it. Can you create a map of an area of the moon? Can you use contours to show the depth of the crater?

ICT Create a power point to share all your information about the moon. You can include transitions between slides and animations on the slides to make your PPT more exciting. Remember to think carefully about the order of animations you choose. (The title needs to arrive first!)

ART Draw or paint a moonscape. You could be on the moon looking back at Earth or on the Earth looking up at the moon.

HISTORY Find out about other missions to the moon. Who was the first person to visit the moon? What year was the mission?
